



HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE

**Is Currently Seeking Nominations For
The York Area Sports Hall Of Fame.**

**If You Know Of An Outstanding Athlete, Coach Or Other Individual Who
Has Spent At Least 10 Years Of His/Her Life In York County
And Has Contributed To The Betterment Of The York Area Community,
Please Make Our Committee Aware Of That Individual.**

The Following Criteria Should Be Met Before Nominating Any Individual:

- A. For athletes in sports generally and commonly thought to have limited career spans, i.e. baseball, football, basketball, etc., he or she must be finished with their playing career for which they are being considered.
- B. For athletes in sports generally and commonly thought to be the lifetime variety, i.e. golf, bowling, hunting, fishing, etc., an athlete must have achieved a clear level of excellence over an extended period of time – not less than 10 years – and be at least 45 years of age.
- C. For coaches and those deemed contributors, patrons and otherwise outstanding supporters in the cause of York County sports, the nominee must have achieved a clear level of excellence over an extended period of time – not less than 10 years – and be at least 45 years of age.
- D. In all cases, the nominee must have made a significant accomplishment or impact at the high school, college, amateur or pro level, with emphasis on SIGNIFICANT.
- E. In all cases, the nominee must have some clear and defined connection to York County, whereas he or she participated in York County sports or contributed in some way to the betterment of the community. Residency alone shall not be sufficient to warrant induction.
